an untidy, twiggy squirrel nest about the size of a football



☐ nuts

can you see any squirrels or jays looking for their stores?



☐ moss

cushion moss in beech woods under oaks or conifers



☐ birds

look for food - red berries on hawthorn, dog rose and holly



☐ mistletoe

balls of mistletoe growing in the tree tops



☐ noise

woodpeckers drumming

hazel catkins in February
