Curriculum expectations

SATs in Y6, the Times Multiplication Check in Y4 and the Phonics Screening Check in Y1 are all a result of the hard work achieved in the previous classes, as much as they are a result of what children do in their current class. I would like to remind you of the importance of reading every day, regular spellings practice, times tables practice and completing weekly homework. Thank you to all our parents for supporting this so that the children at Shenley achieve the best they possibly can in their time here.

Standards

Please ensure that children come to school in full uniform, including black shoes – not trainers. Please ensure that your child keeps their PE kit in school, it is unsafe to wear school uniform for PE lessons. Our target for attendance is 97% however, attendance of 91.5% Spring 2024, 91.4% Summer 2024 and 91.6% Autumn 2024 did not meet this target, we acknowledge that there was a lot of illness, but if your child is well please ensure that they attend school regularly. Equally, good time keeping is essential in order that the children make the best of all their learning opportunities in school. Please remember that toys and jewellery are not allowed in school, simple watches may be worn, which do not have the facility to play games or take photographs of any kind. Please remember that dogs are not allowed on the school premises for the safety of the children.
