Whole school homework overview

Parents:

The whole school homework overview sets out the expectations for each class. Homework tasks will be set on a Friday and due in on the following Thursday. From year 1, children will receive a homework book. Here, the class teachers will share the tasks for the week relevant to the year group expectations. From the summer term of Year 5, homework will progress onto 'Google Classroom' to support the transition to Y6 and then secondary school.

Reading at home

Your child should read for at least 15 minutes every day. This could be the school reading book, library book or a different reading material at home.

All children visit the library each week.



Phonics and spelling

Depending on the year group, phonics phonemes, words or spellings will be sent home to be practised.



Timestable Rockstars & Mathletics

Children from Year 2 to Year 6 can log onto TT Rockstars to practise their timetables.

The class teacher will set 1 weekly online Mathletics task to complete. This links to your current week's maths learning. Once this is completed, children can access other activities if you wish.

Purple Mash

Purple Mash is used to set computing homework, teachers may also use it to set tasks that link to the wider curriculum areas.
