In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- A narrative
- Instructions

As writers, we will be:

- Understanding how to speak about what we are going to write about.
- Forming sentences using capitals, spaces and punctuation.
- Deciding on which information will inform our readers.

In **maths**, we will be learning about: Fractions, multiplication and division, and time.

As mathematicians, we will be:

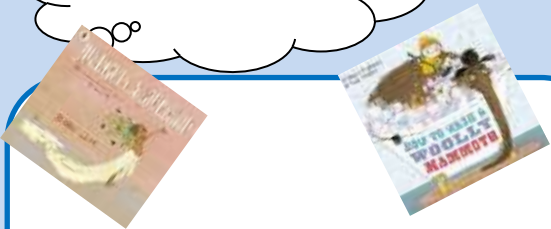
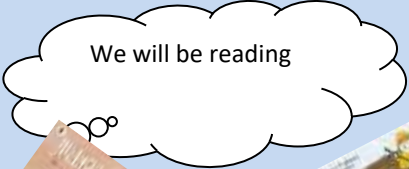
- Using resources to build numbers
- Using mathematical language
- Representing number through writing and drawing
- Using problem solving skills to answer reasoning questions

In **science**, our project will be: Habitats

Our big question is: "Why do animals and plants live in certain habitats"?

As scientists, we will be:

- Asking scientific questions
- Performing simple tests
- Recording information
- Explaining our results



In **guided reading** sessions, we will be developing prediction, fluency and summarising skills.

Reading books will be changed on a Tuesday.

In **art** our project is: Sculpture

We will explore the artwork created by Michelle Reader.

The children will be using recycled materials to create their sculptures.

In **history**, our project is: Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole

Our big question is: "Who was the best nurse - Mary Seacole or Florence Nightingale?"

In **PE**, we will be learning about: Ball control using our hands.

We will be using control and accuracy to throw, pass, bounce and catch.

In **RE**, we will be learning about: Christian, Jewish, Hindu, Humanist and Muslim beliefs.

Our big question is: What is a prophet?

In **PSCHE**, we will be learning about: Families and relationships.

We will be thinking about family, friendships and emotions.
