In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- A recount
- A narrative
- Poetry

As writers, we will be:

- Understanding how to speak about what we are going to write about.
- Forming sentences using capitals, spaces and punctuation.
- Deciding on which information will inform our readers.

In **maths**, we will be learning about: numbers to 100, time and money.

As mathematicians, we will be:

- Using resources to build numbers
- Using mathematical language
- Representing number through writing and drawing
- Using problem solving skills to answer reasoning questions

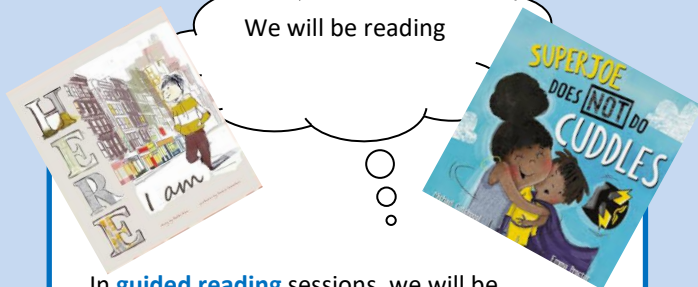
In **science**, our project will be: Plants

Our big question is: "How do seeds and bulbs grow into healthy plants?"

As scientists, we will be:

- Asking scientific questions
- Performing simple tests
- Recording information
- Observing closely

We will be reading



In **guided reading** sessions, we will be developing prediction, fluency and summarizing skills.

Reading books will be changed on a Tuesday.

In **DT** our project is: Food

We will explore healthy, nutritious foods.

The children will be designing a nutritious dip which they could take on a picnic.

In **geography**, our project is: Our environment

Our big question is: Do we have enough bins? Where shall we put a new bin?

In **PE**, we will be learning about: Running and Jumping

We will be: exploring running and jumping using different parts of our bodies

In **RE**, we will be learning about: Christian, Jewish, Hindu, Humanist and Muslim beliefs.

Our big question is: How do we know some people feel a special connection to God?

In **PSCHE/RSHE**, we will be learning about: Safety and the changing body

We will be thinking about who keeps us safe in the community, how to stay safe near a road, who to call in an emergency, and naming parts of the body including those of the private parts for gender.
