

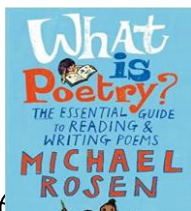


## Shenley Primary School Summer 2 Curriculum Information Page 2026



In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- \*A non chronological report about the importance of play for children
- \* Poetry - Michael Rosen A- Z
- \* An end of year narrative showing off as writers, what we have learnt in Year 4!



In **maths**, we will be focusing on multiplication tables for the first few weeks of this half term, and working towards our Year 4 National multiplication check. As mathematicians, we will be studying:-

- \*Telling the time – days, months, years, seconds, minutes, hours,
- \*Analogue and digital clocks – converting analogue to digital time and vice versa
- \*Direction and position – Describing position using coordinates, plotting coordinates, drawing 2-D shapes on a grid, translating on a grid

In **science**, our topic is 'Habitats, Food chains, and the Digestive System'

As scientists, we will:

- \*Recognise that living things can be classified in a variety of ways /explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment /recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things

- \* The digestive system / Types of animals and their teeth

In **DT**, our topic is: Making Pizza

We will learn how to prepare food hygienically through the design of our own pizza. We will explore different cheeses from different countries and research where the vegetables in pizza come from. We will also learn how to make a delicious tomato sauce.

In **PSCHE/RSHE**, we will be learning about: Safety and the changing body

We will be:

Building awareness of online safety and the benefits and risks of sharing information online; identifying the difference between private and public; age restrictions; the risks associated with tobacco; knowing how to help someone with asthma.

In **Guided reading** sessions, we will be working on all of the reading skills this year, and practising comprehension using these (retrieval, prediction and inference).

Reading books will be changed as and when needed. It is important to listen to your child read as much as you can.

In **PE**, we will be learning the skills of cricket

We will practise skills such as throwing, catching, bowling and batting, while working together and following the rules and playing the game

In **RE**, we will be learning

Does the language of scriptures matter? We will explore how in some religions, the original language is still spoken whilst reading the scriptures

In **computing**, our project is: Making music with programs

We will be learning how to move notes around a screen. We will learn how to change tempo, pitch and dynamics using a computer program on Purple Mash.

In **French**, our project is: Pets and monsters

We will learn the names of different body parts, animals, and noun and verb agreement with masculine and feminine.

In **music**, our topic is Carnival sounds and music

As musicians, we will finish the Romans music topic on motifs/ transposing. We will move onto Carnival sounds and music. We will be able to begin to improvise and layer sounds, and understand and play in syncopated music.
