Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Information Page 2025 - 2026



In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- *A short narrative with a clear moral (inspired by fables)
- *An entertaining non-chronological report

As writers, we will be:

- * Planning our writing and the features we want to use
- *Becoming confident using conjunctions, prepositions and speech punctuation
- * Editing our writing for punctuation and improvements

In **maths**, we will be learning about:

Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division

As mathematicians, we will:

- * Add two and three digit numbers
- * Use inverse operations
- * Use sharing and grouping
- * Multiply by 3, 4 and 8
- * Divide by 3, 4 and 8

In **science**, our project is: Forces and Magnets

Our big question is: Which materials are magnetic?

As scientists, we will:

- * Compare how objects move on different surfaces (conduct a fair test)
- * Group different materials based on whether they are attracted to a magnet
- * Predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other

We will be reading



In **guided reading** sessions, we will be working on our retrieval and vocabulary skills. We will look at a variety of different texts to support us in developing these skills.

Reading books will be changed as and when needed.

In **DT**, our project is: Money containers (Textiles)

As designers, we will be exploring existing wallets and purses.

Children will plan and design a money container for a specific consumer. We will explore sewing techniques such as running stitch and back stitch.

In **Geography**, our topic is: How is London different to Warsaw?

Our big question is: What is the biggest difference between London and Warsaw?

As Geographers, we will be:

- *Looking at maps of the UK, London and Warsaw
- *Locating countries in Europe
- *Describing the human and physical features of London and Warsaw

In **RE**, we will be learning about where our morals come from.

Our big question is: How do we know what is right and wrong?

In **PE**, we will be learning about: Dance and Tag Rugby

We will be focusing on the skills of balance and timing during dance lessons. We will focus on different passes and blocking in tag rugby.

Forest School is on Mondays.

In **PSCHE**, we will be learning about: Celebrating Difference.

We will be looking at how our differences make the world a beautiful place. We will think out acceptance and understanding others.

In **computing**, our project is: Spreadsheets

We will be creating and filling in simple spreadsheets, creating tally charts and developing touch typing skills.

In **French**, our project is: Colour, shape and size

We will be focusing on pronunciation of French colours, different shapes and simple descriptions of size.

In **music**, our topic is: Creating compositions

We will be listening to songs while focusing on structure and use of instruments. We will sing and use glockenspiels to explore pitch and rhythm.
