### Spring Term 2 Curriculum Information Page 2025 - 2026

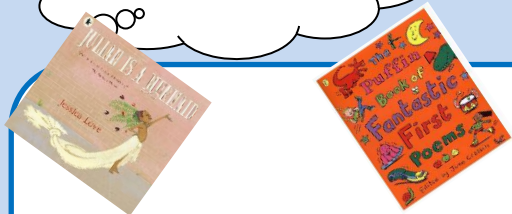
In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- A non-chronological report
- A narrative

As writers, we will be:

- Understanding how to speak about what we are going to write about.
- Forming sentences using capital letters, spaces and punctuation.
- Deciding on which information will inform our readers.

We will be reading



In **guided reading** sessions, we will be developing prediction, fluency and summarising skills.

Reading books will be changed on a Monday.

In **PE**, we will be learning about: locomotion - jumping

We will be: understanding the different reasons when, where and why we jump in different ways.

In **maths**, we will be learning about: Mass, capacity and temperature.

We will be extending our place value knowledge and finding out about height and length.

As mathematicians, we will be:

- Using reasoning to solve number problems
- Understanding the value of digits
- Using a variety of resources to support our learning

In **DT** our project is: Mechanisms

We will be: introducing the concept of winding mechanisms.

The children will be designing and making a vehicle.

In **RE**, we will be learning about: Christian, Jewish, Hindu, Humanist and Muslim beliefs.

Our big question is: Why do we need to give thanks?

In **science**, our project will continue to be: Animals including humans.

Our big question is: "What do all living things need to survive and grow, and how are we similar and different?"

As scientists, we will be:

- Observing closely using simple equipment
- Gathering and recording data
- Describing and comparing

In **History**, our project is: Lewis Hamilton

Our big question is: Why is Lewis Hamilton a significant person?

As historians we will be: Understanding the lives of significant individuals who have contributed to national and international achievements.

In **PSCHE**, we will be learning about: Healthy me

We will be thinking about foods and medicines and making choices to keep us healthy.
