In **English**, we will be writing a range of pieces including:

- \*An entertaining personal narrative (inspired by Jambari Jumps and Ralph Tells a Story)
- \*A calligram poem (inspired by Love That Dog)

As writers, we will be:

- \* Planning our writing and the features we want to use
- \*Becoming confident using conjunctions, prepositions and speech punctuation
- \* Editing our writing for punctuation and improvement

We will be reading



In **guided reading** sessions, we will be working on our retrieval and inference skills. We will look at a variety of different texts to support us in developing these skills.

Reading books will be changed as and when needed.

In **RE**, we will be learning about morality and doing the right thing.

Our big question is: What happens if we do wrong?

In **maths**, we will be learning about:

Fractions and Mass and Capacity

As mathematicians, we will:

- \* Identify unit and non-unit fractions
- \* Add and subtract fractions
- \* Order and compare fractions
- \* Measure in grams, kilograms, litres and millilitres
- \* Add and subtract capacity and volume

In **DT**, our project is: Mechanisms

As Designers, we will be exploring a range of pop-up books.

Children will plan and design a pop-up book using levers, linkages and 3D elements. We will explore a range of existing and popular mechanisms from everyday life.

In **PE**, we will be learning about: Symmetry and Asymmetry

We will be focusing on the skills of timing and movements during PE lessons. We will be creating routines that showcase these skills.

PE is on Fridays and Forest School is on Mondays

In **science**, our project is: Animals Including Humans

Our big question is: What makes a balanced diet?

As scientists, we will:

- \* Investigate the nutritional value of different foods
- \* Group different foods into their food groups
- \* Identify balanced meals and healthier alternatives

In **Geography**, our topic is: Water and The Water Cycle

Our big question is: Why are there hosepipe bans?

As Geographers, we will be:

- \*Locating countries and cities on different types of maps
- \*Researching factual information and the stages of the water cycle
- \*Comparing how water is used

In **PSCHE**, we will be learning about: Healthy Me

We will be looking at making healthy choices and the importance of exercise. We will think about what to do in an emergency.

In **computing**, our project is: Simulations

We will be making and testing our own simulations to represent real and imaginary situations.
